

What is an Evangelist?

εὐαγγελιστής

- "lit., 'a messenger of good' (eu, 'well,' angelos, 'a messenger'), denotes a 'preacher of the Gospel'" (W. E. Vine)
- "A bringer of good tidings, an evangelist... this name is given in the N. T. to those heralds of salvation through Christ who are not apostles" (Thayer).
- Derived from εὐαγγέλιον the word for "gospel"

1 Tim 1:3-7

What is the reason Paul left Timothy in Ephesus? What work was he to be involved in there? What was the primary goal of his teaching?

1 Tim 4:1-16

What was Timothy supposed to help guard against?

What nourishment and exercise did he need to fulfill this work effectively? What can we learn from this passage about the qualities we should look for in evangelists we support?

2 Tim 2:1-2, 14-18, 24-26

What sort of work was Timothy to do with faithful men? What was Timothy to do in reference to those mishandling God's word and straying from the truth?

What qualities did Timothy need to do this work effectively?
