



#### **JEROBOAM** 1 Kings 12:25-14:20


- In charge of Solomon's forced laborers

- Set up golden calves in Dan and Bethel








- Reigned 3 years in Jerusalem
- Prevailed in war against Jeroboam









1 Kings 15:9-24 2 Chron 14-16


- Reigned 41 years in Jerusalem
- Removed idolatry from Judah
- Trusted God against Ethiopia, but Syria against Baasha








#### **NADAB** 1 Kings 15:25-32


- Reigned 2 years in Tirzah
- Killed by Baasha















- Reigned 2 years in Tirzah
- Killed by Zimri




#### **ZIMRI** 1 Kings 16:15-20

- Reigned 7 days in Tirzah
- Attacked by Omri, the commander of the army
- Killed himself by burning down the palace



#### **OMRI** 1 Kings 16:21-28


- Overcame Tibni to take the throne
- Reigned 6 years in Tirzah and 6 in Samaria
- Military success mentioned on the Moabite stone



#### AHAB

1 Kings 16:29-22:40


- Reigned 22 years in Samaria (Palace in Jezreel)
- Married Jezebel / worshipped Baal and Asherah
- Elijah Drought / Mt Carmel / Naboth's Vineyard
- Allied with Judah / War with Syria (Died in Battle)



#### JEHOSHAPHAT


1 Kings 22:41-50 2 Chron 17-20

- Reigned 25 years in Jerusalem
- Sent officials to teach the Law throughout Judah
- Made a marriage alliance with Ahab




**AHAZIAH** 1 Kings 22:51 – 2 Kings 1:18

- Reigned 2 years in Samaria
- Inquired of Baal-zebub after falling through lattice
- Elijah prophesied his death



#### **JORAM** 2 Kings 3:1-8:6


- Reigned 12 years in Samaria
- Removed pillar of Baal, but continued in idolatry
- Elisha Wars w/ Moab and Syria



#### JEHORAM


2 Kings 8:16-24 2 Chron 21

- Reigned 8 years in Jerusalem
- Married to Ahab's daughter Athaliah
- Killed all his brothers to secure the throne
- Struck with an incurable disease in his bowels




AHAZIAH 1 Kings 8:25-29 2 Chron 22:1-9

- Reigned 1 year in Jerusalem
- Counselled by his mother Athaliah
- Joined Joram in battle against Syria






- Ruled 28 years in Samaria
- Killed household of Ahab (both Joram & Ahaziah)
- Killed prophets of Baal, but continued in idolatry



**ATHALIAH** 1 Kings 11:1-3 2 Chron 22:10-12


- Reigned 6 years in Jerusalem
- Killed all of the royal household except Joash (protected by his aunt Jehosheba, wife of Jehoiada the priest)



#### JOASH


2 Kings 11:4-12:21 2 Chron 23-24

- Reigned 40 years in Jerusalem (Assassinated)
- Served God all the days of Jehoiada the priest
- Restored temple / turned to idolatry in latter years




JEHOAHAZ 2 Kings 13:1-9

- Reigned 17 years in Samaria
- Suffered great defeats against Syria
- Sought God in time of despair and was delivered




#### JEHOASH 2 Kings 13:10-25

- Reigned 16 years in Samaria
- Military success against Syria and Judah
- Death of Elisha



AMAZIAH 2 Kings 14:1-22 2 Chron 25

- Reigned 29 years in Jerusalem (Assassinated)
- Became prideful after God gave victory over Edom
- Served gods of Edom / Defeated by Israel







- Reigned 29 years in Jerusalem (Assassinated)

#### JEROBOAM II 2 Kings 14:23-29


- Reigned 41 years in Samaria

- Borders restored as prophesied by Jonah









- Reigned 55 years in Jerusalem

# ZECHARIAHReigned 6 months in Samaria (Assassinated)2 Kings 15:8-12




# SHALLUMReigned 1 month in Samaria (Assassinated)2 Kings 15:13-16




#### MENAHEM 2 Kings 15:17-22

- Gave tribute to Pul, king of Assyria




# PEKAHIAH Reigned 2 years in Samaria (Assassinated) 2 Kings 15:23-26



#### **PEKAH** 2 Kings 15:27-31


- Reigned 20 years in Samaria (Assassinated)

2 Kings 15:32-38 2 Chron 27


- Reigned 16 years in Jerusalem
- Given victory of Ammonites



AHAZ


2 Kings 16 2 Chron 28

- Reigned 16 years in Jerusalem
- Reintroduced idolatry and child sacrifice in Judah
- Allied with the King of Assyria after suffering defeats from Israel, Syria, Edom, and Philistia






- Reigned 9 years in Samaria
- Rebelled against Shalmaneser, king of Assyria
- Samaria destroyed and all Israel taken captive



#### HEZEKIAH

2 Kings 18-20 2 Chron 29-32


- Reigned 29 years in Jerusalem
- Major spiritual revival / Trusts God against Assyria
- Healed of sickness in answer to prayer
- Defeat by Babylon foretold in response to pride




#### MANASSEH 2 Kings 21:1-18

2 Chron 33:1-20

- Reigned 55 years in Jerusalem
- Idolatry / child sacrifice / much innocent blood
- Repentance after capture by King of Assyria






#### JOSIAH


2 Kings 22:1-23:30 2 Chron 34-35

- Dies in battle with Pharoah Neco










#### **BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY**

606 BC






**JEHOIACHIN** 2 Kings 24:8-17


2 Chron 36:9-10
